 Cleaning/Litter Jet washers are **NOT** to be used at this event. All litter must be removed from site
 Marshalls/Helpers We are always looking for volunteers to help prior, during and after the events
 Track Clearing To appear in the race results you must hand in your tag if it isn't taken off you at timing in
 Other Information Any additional information will be given at the riders meeting (9:45 approx)
 Cancellation In case of adverse weather conditions we will contact all riders booked in that the event is cancelled and it will also be placed on our website.
